The Company

STALICLA SA is a Swiss clinical stage biopharmaceutical company leading omics-based precision medicine drug development for patients with neurodevelopmental disorders (NDDs), with a first application in Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

STALICLA is on a unique mission to identify clinically actionable patient subgroups and develop tailored treatments for those most impaired by their symptoms.

Its DEPI technology is the first platform specifically developed to enable precision medicine in complex NDDs. The platform integrates comprehensive metabolomics, whole-genome sequencing, RNA sequencing and its advanced HC match module to pair patient biological signatures with drug candidates. DEPI has reached clinical proof of concept with its first pipeline candidate, STP1, currently in clinical trials in the US.

In 4 years, STALICLA has validated its platform model and proven its potential to significantly accelerate the time to clinic developing STP1 as a first in class precision treatment for a biological subgroup of patients with ASD (this group ASD-Phen1 is estimated to represent 1.5 - 2M people in the EU and North America). STP1 entered clinical trials (Phase 1b), in the US, in December 2020.

The role

As a rapidly growing company, STALICLA is currently expanding its team and opening – for immediate entry – a Senior Project Manager position.

Reporting to the CEO, the Senior Project Manager will be responsible for identifying, contracting, and executing key partnerships of the company, in particular involving the use

of the DEPI platform to support Precision Medicine approaches of pharmaceutical companies and institutions in NDD.

He/She will be expected to provide advanced support to the CEO through a variety of strategic and business development tasks and projects.

This role is an exciting career opportunity for an experienced, hands-on, fast-learning and dedicated individual willing to join a mission-driven, high-paced environment.

Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Manage the key partnerships with GATHER Foundation from negotiation and contractual agreement, project planning (including timelines, resources, budget, administration and reports), project execution, and monitoring
- Manage other strategic projects for STALICLA upon request from the CEO
- Coordinate with the developer team of the STALICLA DDS Unit the technical work performed for GATHER Foundation and monitor documentation and deliverables
- Report activities performed by STALICLA for GATHER Foundation (i) to the CEO of STALICLA and (ii) to the GATHER Foundation board and its administrative coordinator
- Support the Administrative Coordinator of GATHER Foundation in any aspects requiring technical and/or scientific expertise

- Manage the activities of the Project Manager Associate on the GATHER project.

Requirements

- MD or PhD level in medical, biology, or bioinformatics field is a must
- Minimum 3 years of experience in pharma or CRO, with good knowledge of the pharma R&D environment
